Who are we?

The NGO Development Center (NDC) is an innovative Palestinian non-profit organization established in November 2006 in response to the need of having a sustainable Palestinian mechanism for providing financial and technical support to the NGO sector.

NDC is governed by a policy board of directors that is composed of representatives from society experts, NGO networks and unions, academia, and the private sector. It is composed of 13 members elected by the general assembly once every three years.

Our vision

NDC aspires to realize the following vision:

“An effective NGO sector which contributes to building Palestinian civil society”.

Our mission

By providing financial and technical support, NDC works towards developing the capacities of Palestinian NGOs in providing quality services, especially to the poor and the marginalized; enhancing their self-reliance; and empowering NGOs to be more sustainable.

Concurrently, NDC contributes towards the development of the NGO sector as a whole by facilitating the sharing and exchange of information and experience; by supporting research and policy development; and by strengthening the NGO sector relationships with the development partners.

Our objectives

- 1- Empowering NGOs to provide quality services that are responsive to the priorities of the Palestinian society.
- 2- NGO sector is more efficient and capable to influence the formulation of national policies and plans.
- 3- NDC is a main address for supporting and developing the NGO sector and its institutions.
- 4- NDC is more competent and responsive to the various needs of the community.
- 5- NDC possesses the means that would enhance its financial and administrative capabilities.

NDC Programs

Grants Facility Program

NDC provides a distinctive combination of direct grants to NGOs, to help them perform with improved quality and better directed outcomes, while increasing access to services by the poor and marginalized. NDC uses different granting schemes to allow NGOs with various capacities and magnitudes to focus on sectors and themes where NGOs have a comparative advantage.

The main granting schemes are:

- Empowerment Grants
- Partnership Grants
- Small Grants
- Emergency Grants

NGO Sector Development Program

This program aims at developing the NGO sector as a whole to become more responsive, transparent, and accountable to Palestinian communities and the donor community by setting standards, promoting collaboration within the sector and strategic policy research and planning.

The main components of this program are:

- NGO Code of Conduct
- Sector Coordination and Information Exchange
- Policy and Research

Human Rights & Good Governance Secretariat

NDC serves as the program management unit responsible for channeling pooled donor funding, supporting coordinated initiatives and joint capacity building initiatives, and strengthening policy dialogue for NGOs that are working to promote and protect Human Rights/Good Governance in West Bank and Gaza Strip.

The overall developmental objective of the HR/GG Program is to improve Human Rights and Good Governance in the oPt through the following three mechanisms:

1. Channeling of Funds
2. Strategic Sector Development
3. Policy Dialogue
